#### **EXPLANATION OF ADJUSTMENTS**

#### Office of the State's Attorney

The Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention awarded \$160,000 to support the immediate and long-term housing needs of the victims of domestic violence as a result of the Coronavirus pandemic.

#### **Judicial Branch/ Circuit Court**

The Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention awarded \$26,667 to assist in the development and implementation of an economic empowerment program designed to help survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault, and sex trafficking to overcome economic barriers to achieve long-term financial independence and safety. Additional appropriation authority in the amount of \$1,667 is needed to fully expend the award received.

#### **Board of Elections**

The Center for Tech and Civic Life awarded \$1,325,384 for the public purpose of planning and operationalizing a safe and secure election administration in Prince George's County for the November 6, 2020 general election.

#### **Non-Departmental**

The Maryland Department of Commerce COVID-19 Restaurant Assistance Program awarded \$9,768,158 for the Restaurant Relief Fund grant that will be implemented by the Economic Development Corporation. Funding will enable the County to issue grants to restaurants to promote and encourage stabilization within the hospitality and restaurant industry. Grant proceeds from the program include: working capital, such as rent, payroll, and job training; purchase of equipment and services to expand outdoor dining, such as tents, heaters, warmers, and carts; infrastructure improvements, such as heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) system upgrades; technology support carryout and delivery; purchase of personal protective equipment (PPE) and disposable food containers and utensils; and sanitization services. Additional appropriation authority in the amount of \$3,663,059 is needed to fully expend the received award.

The Office of Management and Budget requests \$16,000,000 towards Unanticipated Grant Awards/ Interim Appropriations given the many COVID-19 related grants that agencies are awarded in between quarterly supplemental request to the Council. An additional \$8,000,000 in appropriation authority is requested.

Maryland's Department of Commerce awarded \$11,430,867 to provide grants to hotels with loss of revenue and ongoing COVID-19 expenses, such as the purchase of PPE and normal operating costs. Eligible hotels must have at least 10 rooms (except qualifying bed and breakfasts) and demonstrate at least a 25% reduction in revenue compared to April-November 2019.

#### **Health Department**

The Maryland Department of Health awarded \$1,230,236 for the Fee-for-Service Supplement program. Funding supports budget shortfalls associated with the fee-for-service clinics.

The Maryland Department of Health awarded \$17,186,797 for the COVID-19 Vaccines program. Funding will assist the focus on equitable access and distribution of Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) vaccines and vaccination activities.

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Center for Disease Control and Prevention through the Maryland Department of Health, Prevention and Health Promotion Administration awarded the Epidemiology and Laboratory Capacity (ELC) - Enhancing Detection Grant. Funding will support laboratory testing, laboratory data to enhance investigation, response and prevention for Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) and severe acute respiratory syndrome Coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2). The program objective is to protect public health and safety by enhancing the capacity of public health agencies to effectively detect, respond, prevent and control known and emerging infectious diseases.

The U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency, through the Maryland Department of Health, Prevention and Health Promotion Administration award \$6,768,000 for the Emergency Protective Measures. Funding will support the purchase of personal protective equipment, supplies for storage, handling, distributing, transporting and

administering COVID-19 vaccines. Funding also supports facility costs, medical and support staff, emergency medical care associated with the vaccine administration, medical waste disposal and communications to disseminate public information.

#### **Department of Housing and Community Development**

The U.S. Department of Treasury awarded \$27,180,293 to assist households that are unable to pay rent, utilities, and those costs in arrears due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The assistance targets Prince George's County residents who qualify for unemployment, demonstrate a risk of experiencing homelessness or housing instability, and/or have a household income at or below 80 percent of the median area.

The Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development awarded \$2,672,725 to provide rental assistance to households whose income has been negatively impacted by the loss of employment or reduction in hours as a result of the COVID-19 crisis.

The Lincoln Institute of Land Policy awarded \$50,000 to provide funding to support the preservation and development of multi-family rental properties along the Purple Line Corridor. The Lincoln Institute will fund a consultant to provide real estate advisory and underwriting expertise to evaluate and underwrite the right of first refusal offers submitted to DHCD.

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development awarded an additional \$5,162,659 for the Community Development Block Grant for a broad range of physical improvements for those areas of the County designated for redevelopment and revitalization. Additional appropriation authority in the amount of \$133,059 is needed to fully expend the award received.

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development awarded an additional \$441,932 for the Hearth Emergency Solutions Grant to support the provision of emergency, transitional and supportive shelter assistance to the homeless and other temporarily displaced County residents. Additional appropriation authority in the amount of \$18,732 is needed to fully expend the award received.
