**REPORT:** Favorable 11-0: Council Members Hawkins, Anderson-Walker, Davis, Dernoga, Franklin, Glaros, Ivey, Harrison, Streeter, Taveras and Turner.

The Prince George's County Council convened as the Committee of the Whole on February 18, 2021 to consider the appointment of Mr. Michael L. Riddick to serve on the Prince George's County Commission for Veterans. The Commission serves to elevate, develop and promote new and existing programs and services for Veterans and their families here in Prince George's County.

Ms. Miriam Brewer, Liaison, Office of the County Executive, introduced Mr. Riddick, a resident of Clinton, Maryland with over thirty-eight (38) years of experience as a veteran and was honorably discharged in 2004. He entered the United States Army in 1983 and served various assignments across the world. Mr. Riddick is a life-member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars, American Legion, Disabled America Veterans, and the National Association for Black Veterans. He currently serves as a National Service Officer providing information, counseling and claims service to veterans and their dependents. If confirmed Mr. Riddick's term would expire October 28, 2024.

After a brief discussion and comments from Mr. Riddick, the Committee of the Whole unanimously voted the appointment of Mr. Michael L. Riddick to the Commission for Veterans favorably, 11-0.
