Sec. 13-101. Code	e – Housing Code Adoption.
(a) The Inter	rnational Property Maintenance Code, [2000] 2018 Edition, as published by
the International C	ode Council, Inc. (hereinafter "the Housing Code"), is adopted by this
reference and made	e a part of this Subtitle as though set out in full herein with the additions,
exceptions, and mo	odifications set forth in Subdivision 2 of this Division.

- (b) At least three (3) copies of the International Property Maintenance Code, <u>2018</u> Edition, shall be on file in the office of the Clerk of the Council for public inspection and use.
- (c) Where a conflict arises, the provisions of this Sub-title as amended by the County shall control.

Sec. 13-121. - Same; [Section 306] Section 309, [Extermination] Pest Elimination.

- (a) Section 306.3 is amended to read as follows: "309.2 Single occupancy. The owner of a one-family dwelling or of a single-tenant nonresidential structure shall be responsible for [extermination] pest elimination on the premises."
- (b) Section 306.4 is amended to read as follows: "309.4 Multiple occupancy. The owner of a structure containing two (2) or more dwelling units, a multiple occupancy, a rooming house, or a nonresidential structure shall be responsible for [extermination] pest elimination."
- (c) Section 306.5 is amended to read as follows: "309.5 Continued maintenance. The owner of any structure shall be responsible for the continued rodent- and pest-free condition of the structure."

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SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, subparagraph, subsection, or section.
