The Prince George's County Council's Committee of the Whole (COW) reviewed the four (4) reservation plats which are due to expire on June 30, 2021. The County Council understands that these reservation plats were established for facilities recommended in adopted and approved master plans.

The COW met on March 30, 2021 and recommended the reservation plats listed below be extended for one additional year:

1.	Branch Avenue/Surratts Road Interchange Parcel A Summit Creek	VJ 162-42 0.85 acres
2.	Branch Avenue/Surratts Road Interchange Parcel B, C, E and G Summit Creek	VJ 171-84 3.64 acres
3.	US 301 Upgrade Part of Lot 4 Bowling Heights	REP 193-31 3.60 acres

The County Council supports the Committee of the Whole recommendation to allow reservation plats 1, 2 and 3 to be extended for one (1) additional year. This support is contingent on the agreement of the respective property owners
