RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION concerning

Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission

For the purpose of transferring certain appropriations and expenditures between certain programs in the Fiscal Year 2020–21 Operating Budget for the Recreation Fund.

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget and Appropriation Ordinance for Fiscal Year 2020–21 for the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission was adopted by CB-23-2020; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Land Use Article, Section 18-108, the budget may be amended by resolution by the respective County Councils on their initiative or at the request of the respective County Executives, and after public hearing upon reasonable notice to the public; and

WHEREAS, CB-23-2020 identified funding for certain recreation programs, in particular, College Park Boys and Girls Club, Maryland Cheer Chargers, and Prince George's Youth Lacrosse; and

WHEREAS, since the adoption of CB-23-2020, it has been determined that the College Park Boys and Girls Club, Maryland Cheer Chargers, and the Prince George's Youth Lacrosse recreation programs will not be able to utilize the program funds as anticipated in the FY 2020– 21 year; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to increase or provide funding for the Forestville Boys and
Girls Club of Prince George's County, Maryland, Inc.; the Kettering-Largo-Mitchellville Boys
and Girls Club, Inc.; the Laurel Boys and Girls Club, Inc.; the Laurel Historical Society; and the

1 Student Athletes for Educational Opportunities (SAFEO), Inc.; and

WHEREAS, in order to identify funding for these recreation programs, there is a need to decrease funding in the Recreation Fund for the College Park Boys and Girls Club, Maryland Cheer Chargers, and the Prince George's Youth Lacrosse.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, sitting as the District Council for that part of the Maryland-Washington Regional District in Prince George's County, Maryland, that the following adjustments to the approved Fiscal Year 2020–21 Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission Operating Budget Recreation Fund programs, as approved in CB-23-2020, are hereby made for the purposes set forth above:
