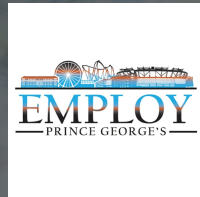

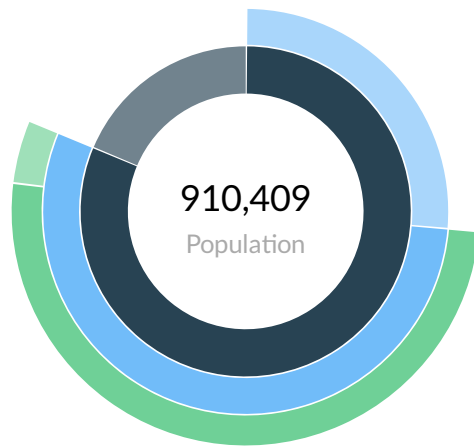
Median household income is **\$22.1K above** the national median household income of \$62.8K.

## Takeaways

- From 2015 to 2020, jobs **declined by 0.3%** in Prince George's County, MD from 353,188 to **352,291**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 1.3% by 1.6%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate increased from 65.7% to 67.6% between 2015 and 2020**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **18.7% of Prince George's County, MD residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (1.3% below the national average), and **6.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.4% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2020 are Federal Government, Civilian, Education and Hospitals (State Government), and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).

## Educational Attainment

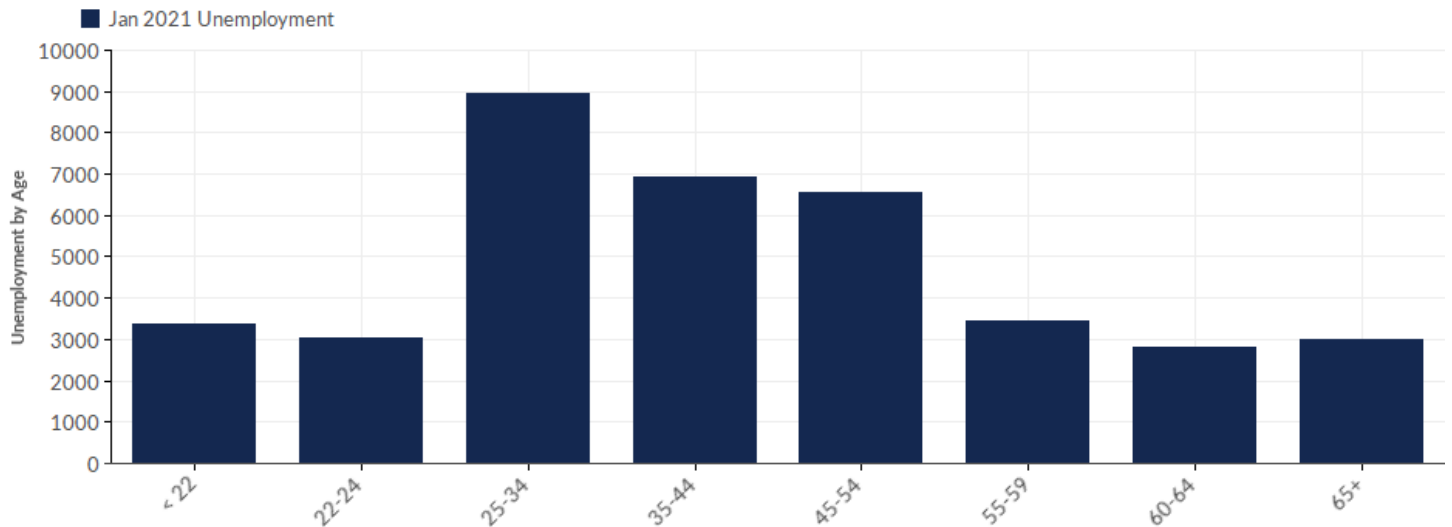

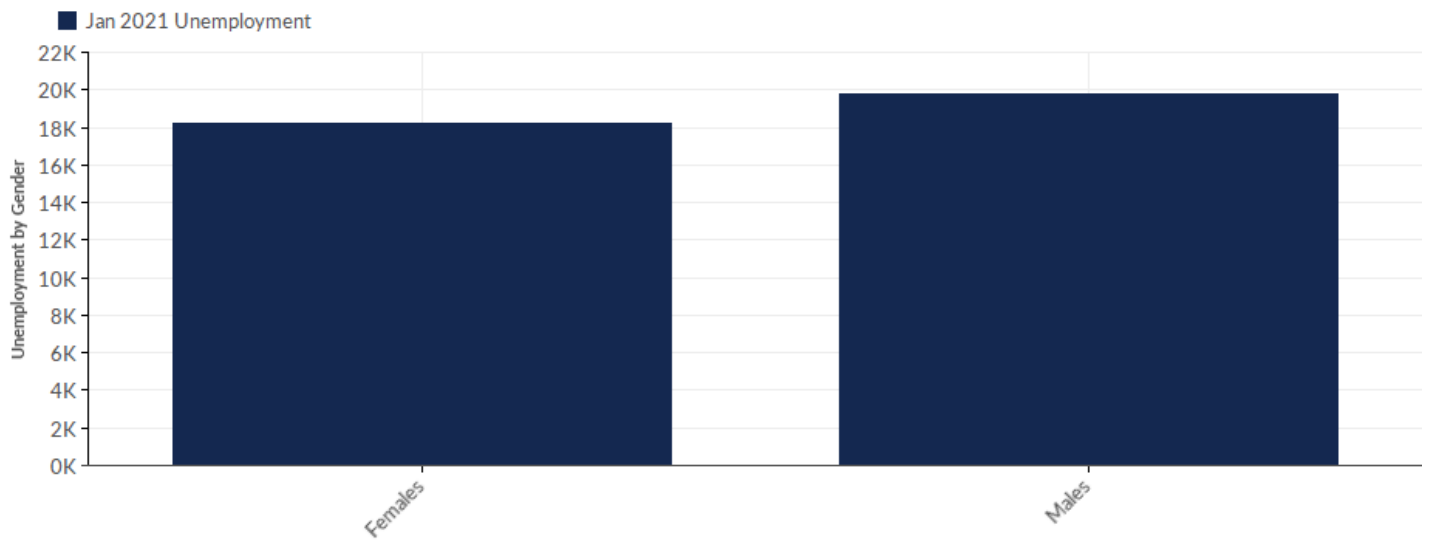

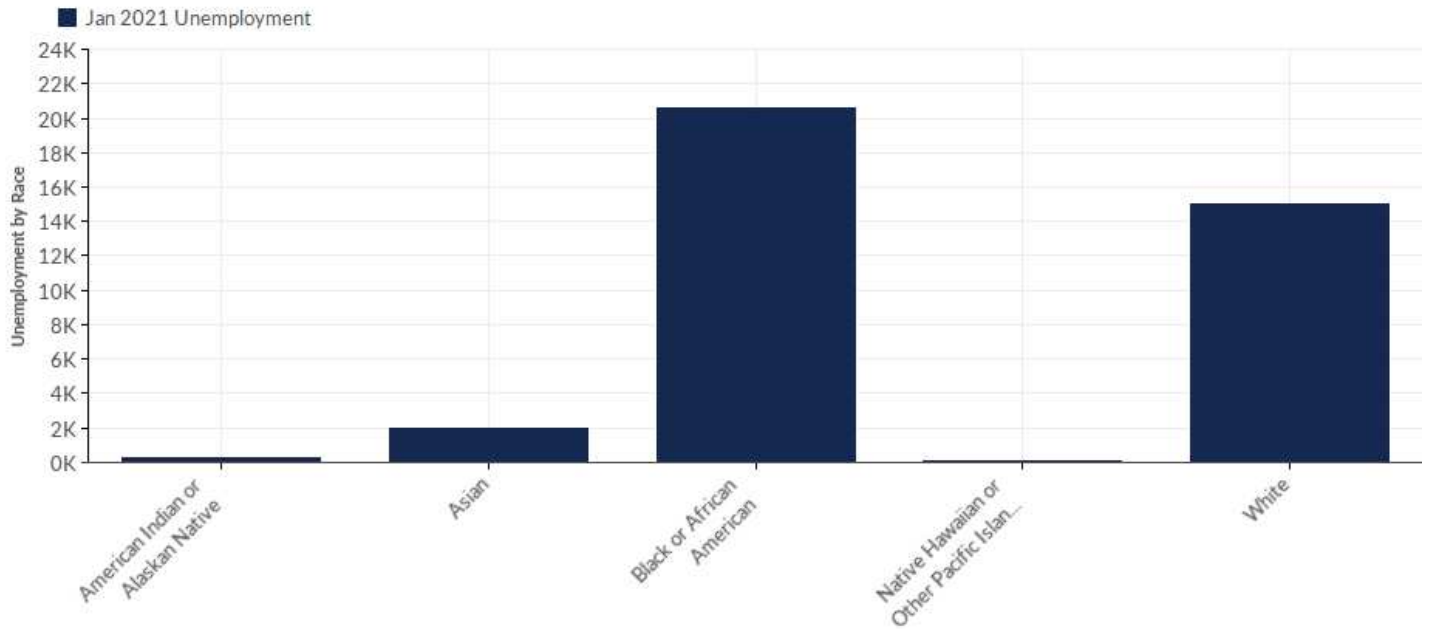

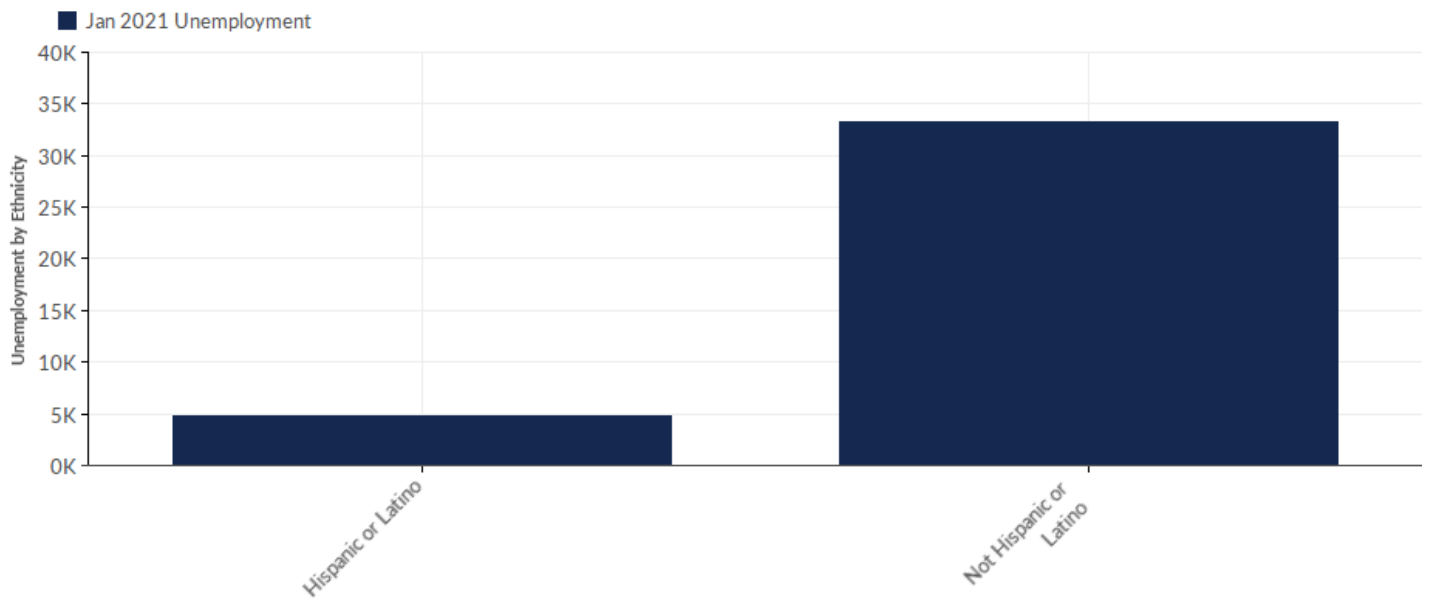

## Unemployment by Ethnicity

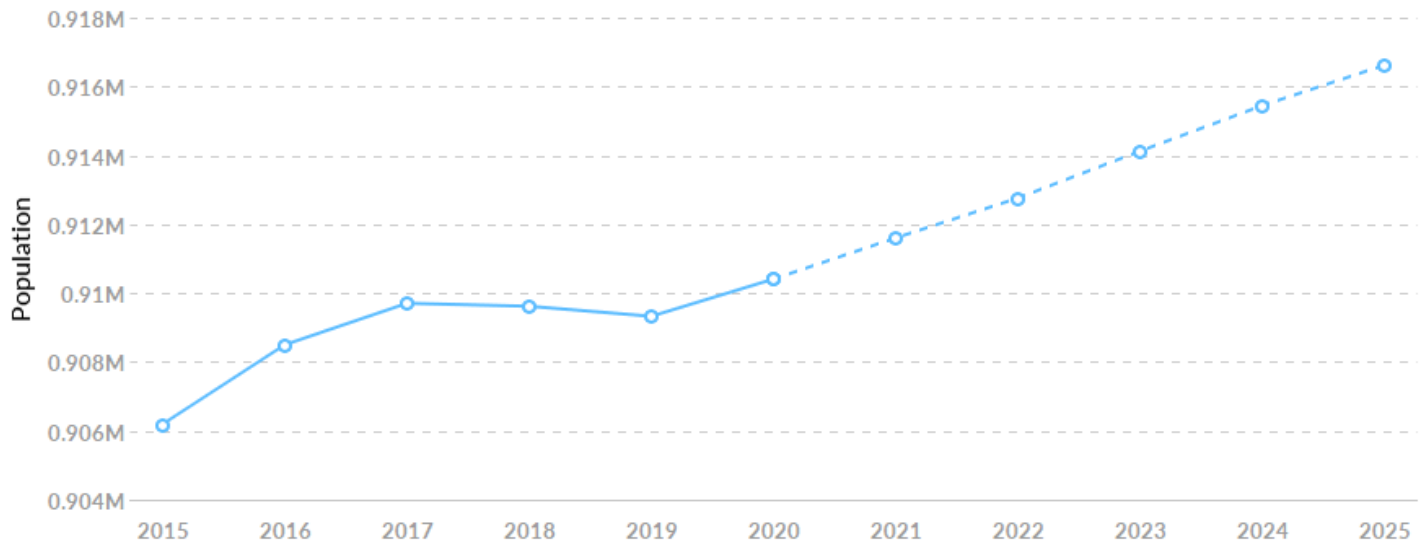

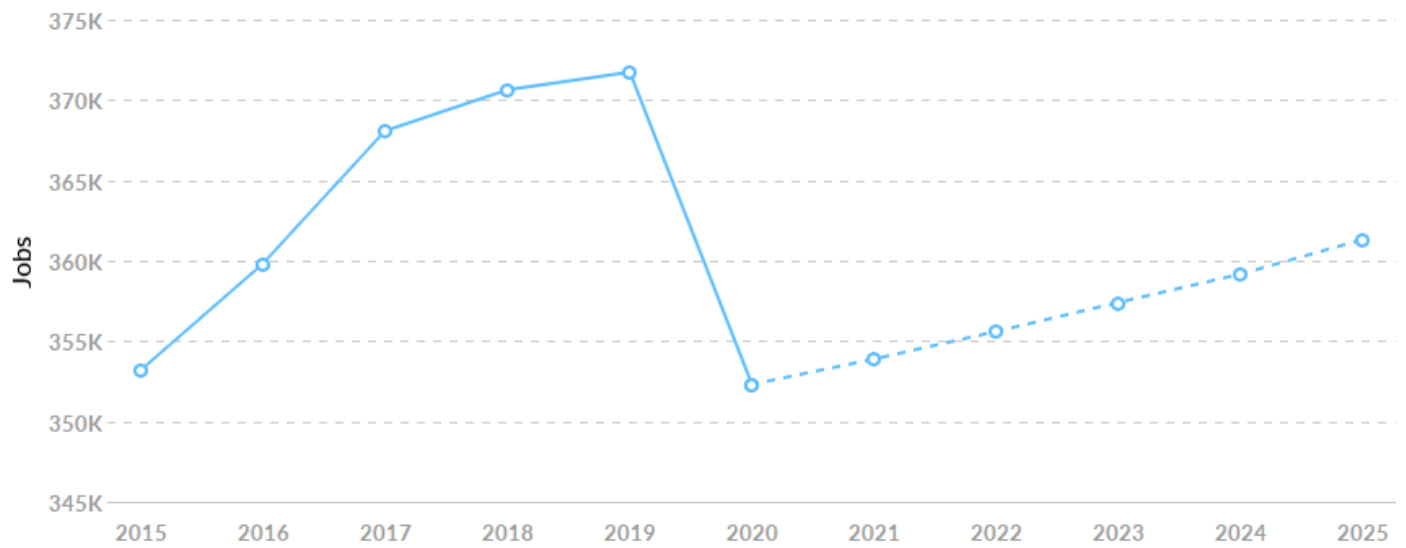

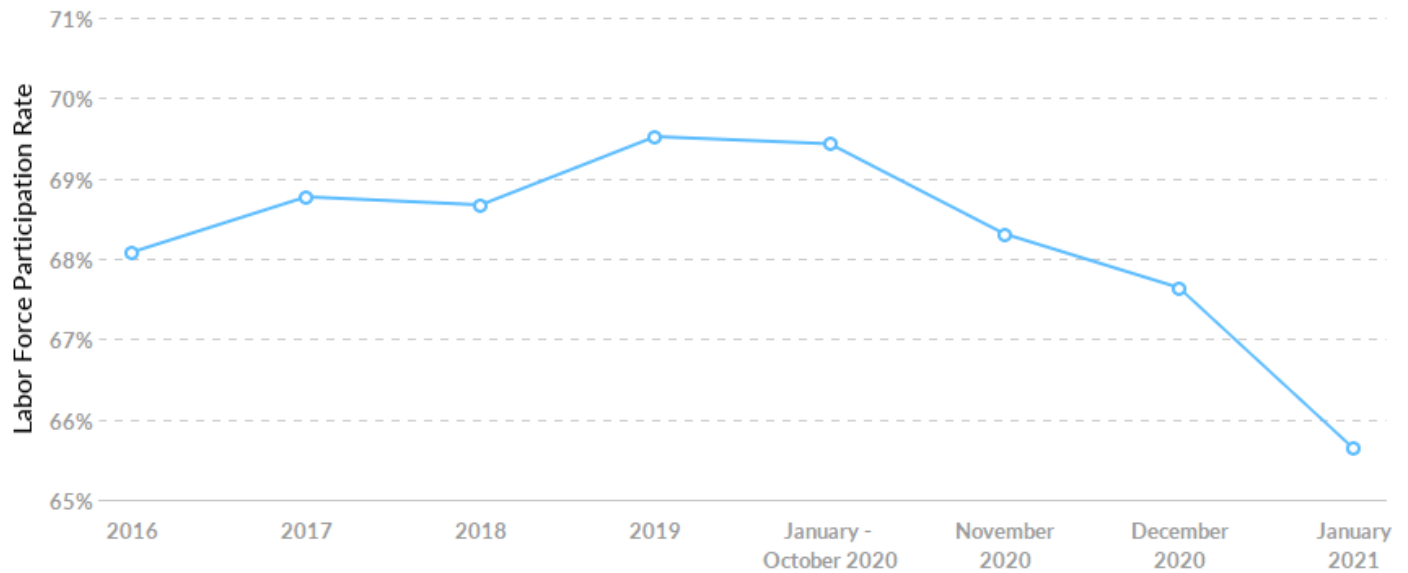
## Job Trends

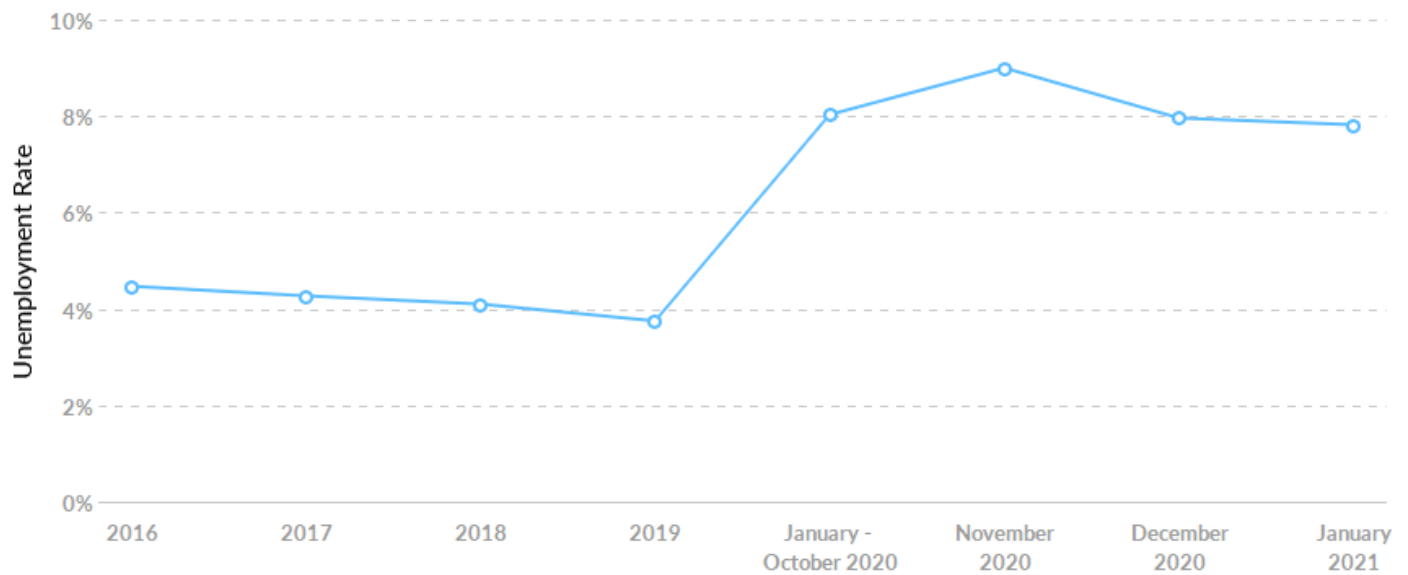

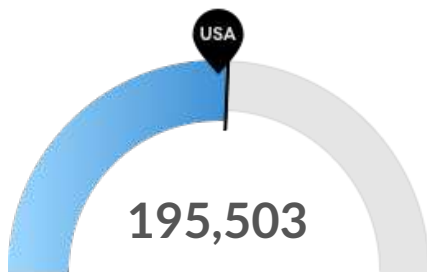

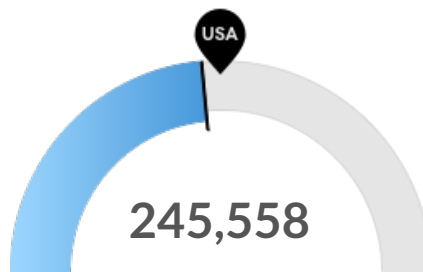

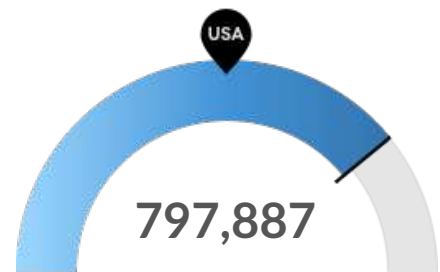
Prince George's County, MD has 195,503 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 187,489.

**Retiring Soon**

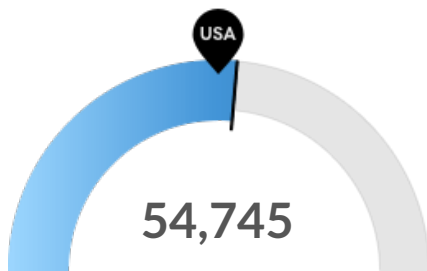
Retirement risk is about average in Prince George's County, MD. The national average for an area this size is 267,354 people 55 or older, while there are 245,558 here.

**Racial Diversity**

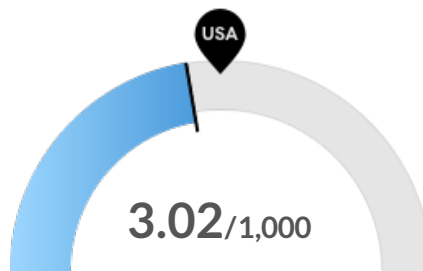
Racial diversity is high in Prince George's County, MD. The national average for an area this size is 362,717 racially diverse people, while there are 797,887 here.

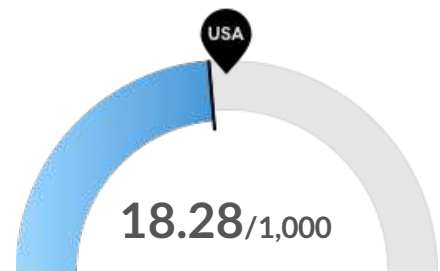

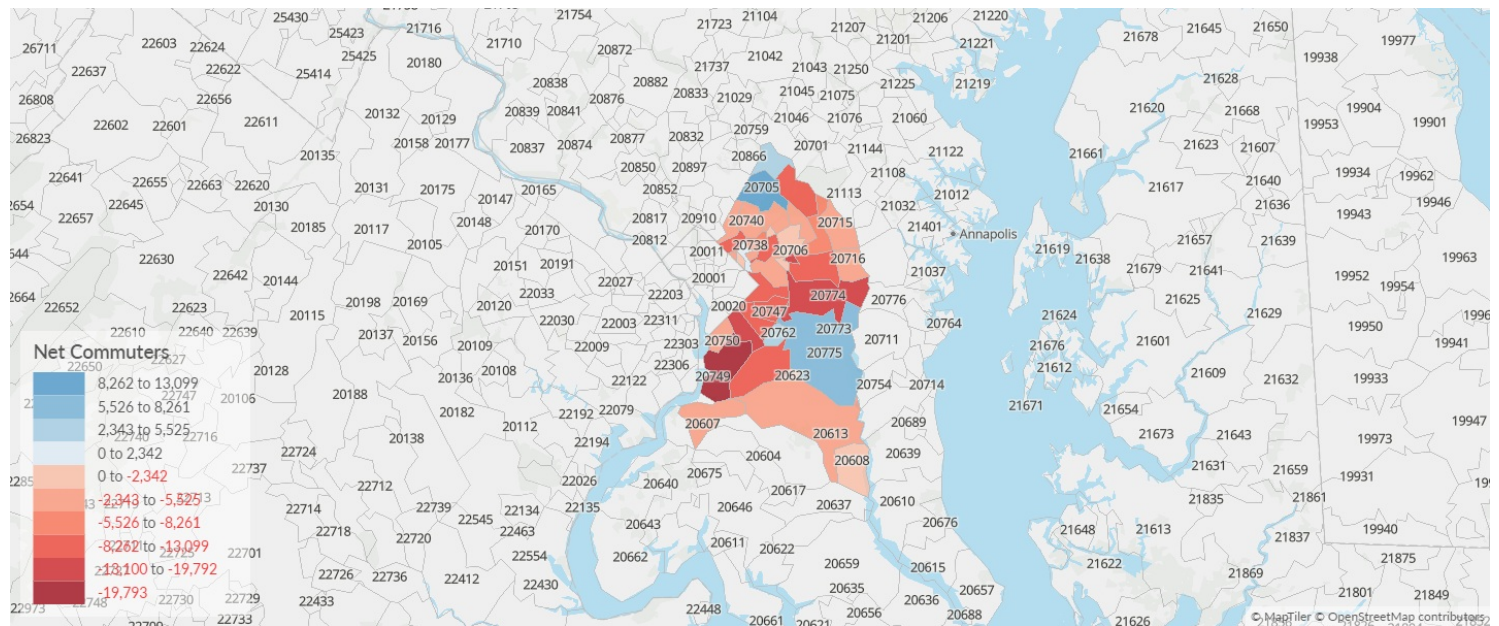

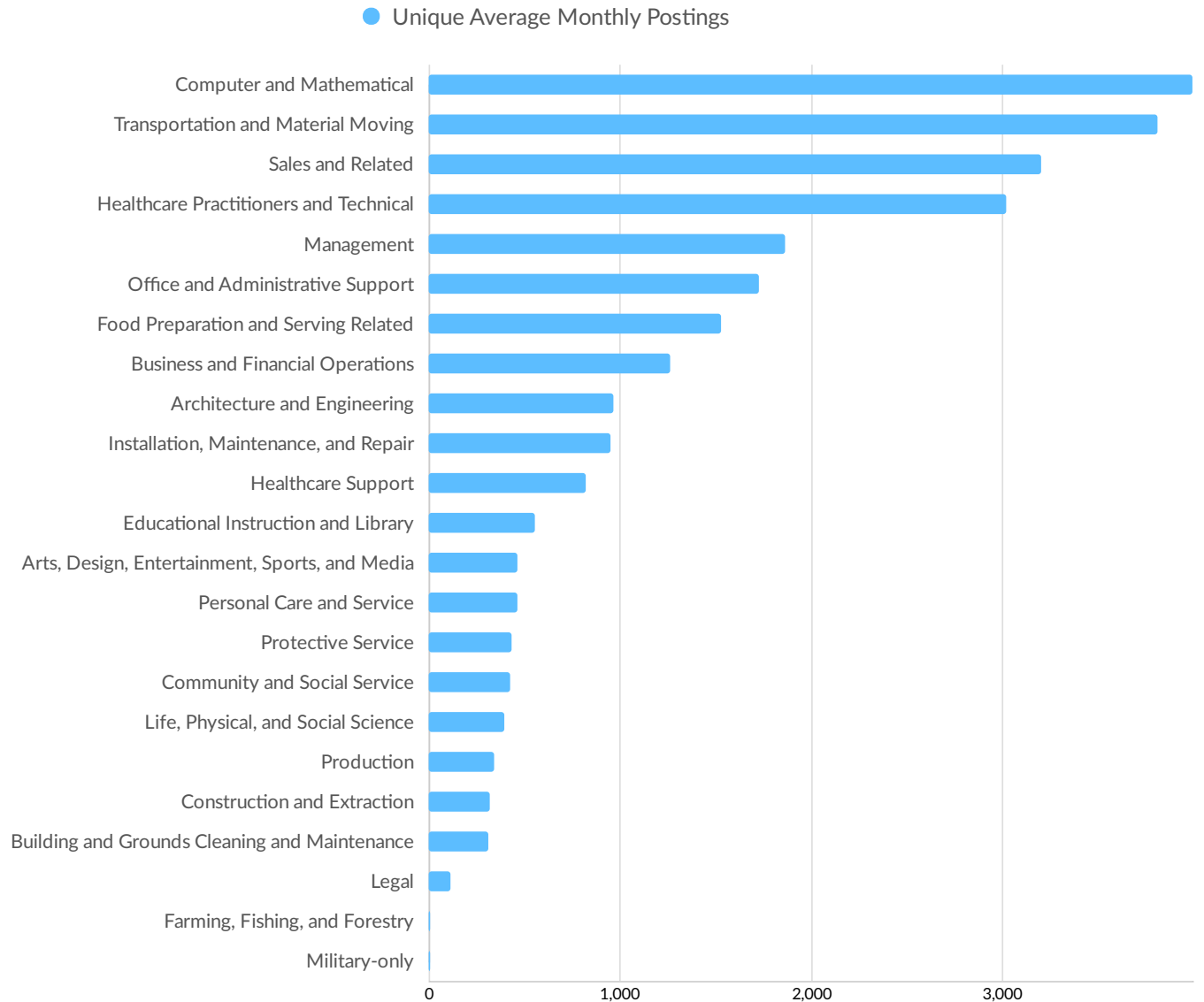

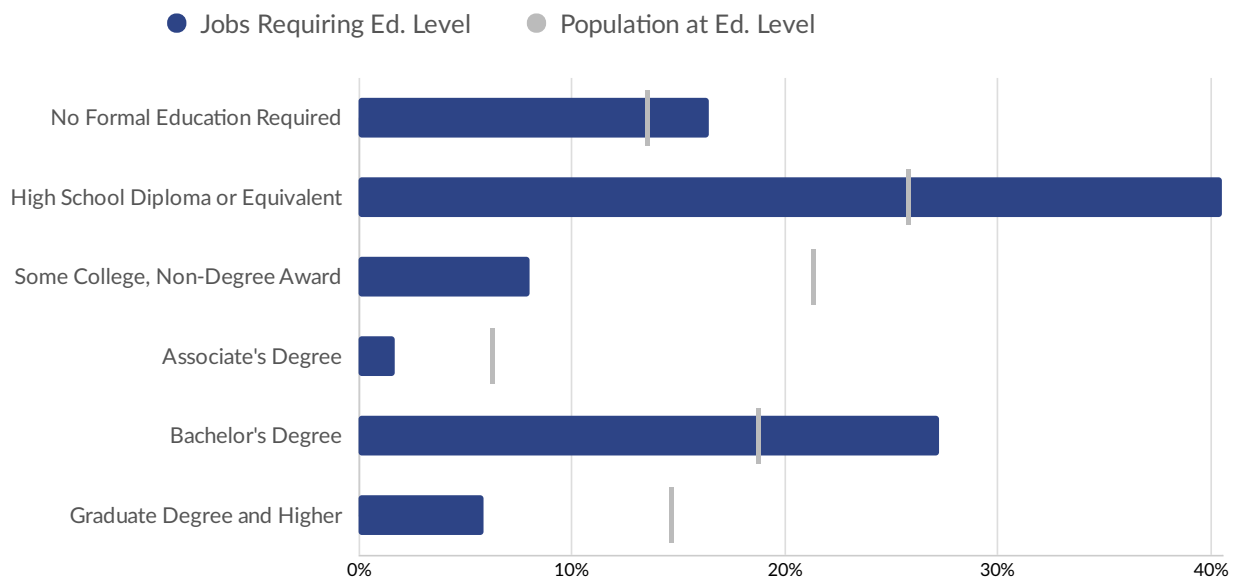

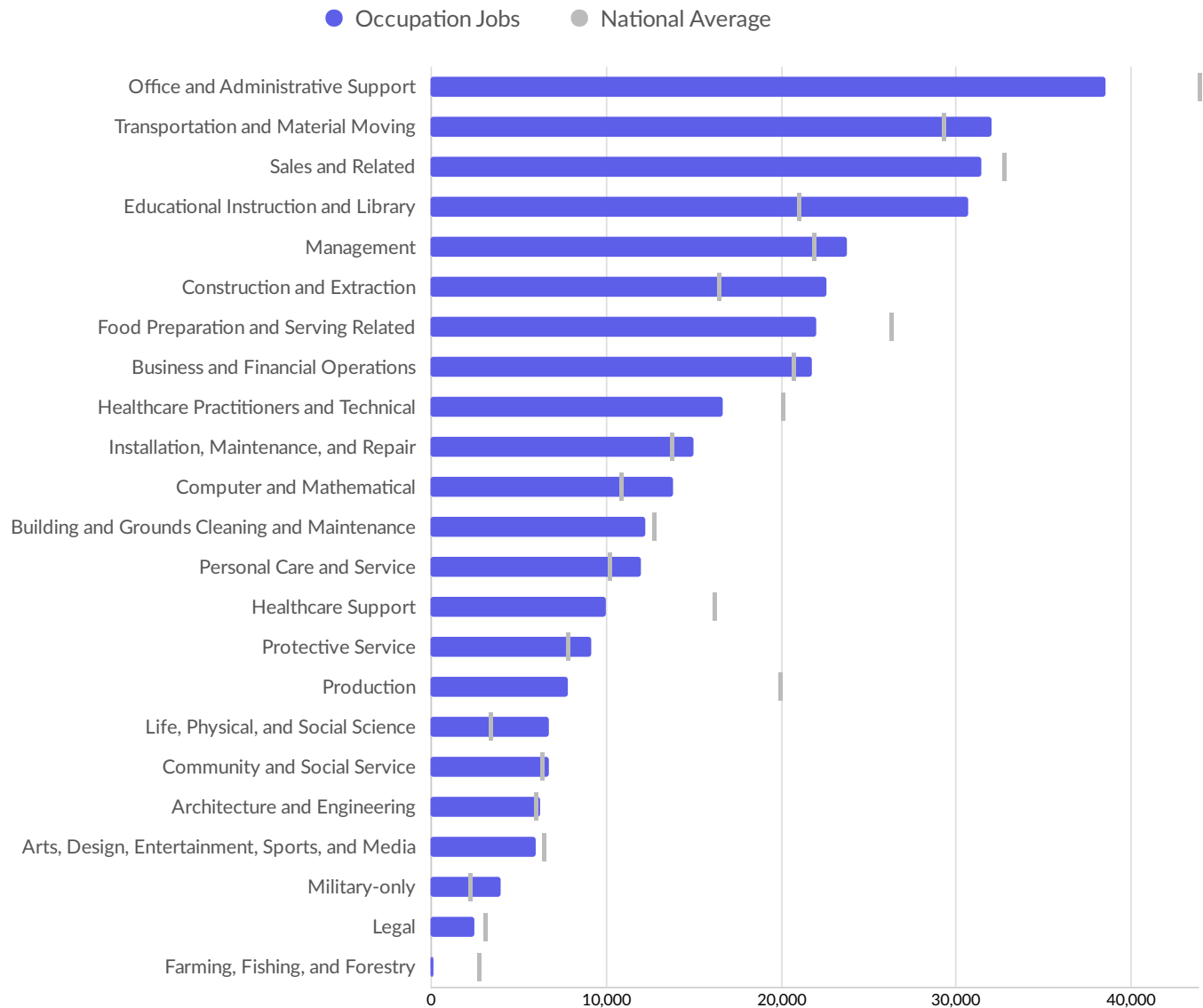
