

As the workforce development entity for Prince George's County Government, Employ Prince George's serves as the staff, fiscal agent and administrative agent of the Prince George's County Workforce Development Board, the entity managing and distributing the County's Workforce Innovation & Opportunity Act (WIOA) Title I funds, and the administrator of the Prince George's County Public Workforce System.

Employ Prince George's is an industry leading workforce development service provider, administering over 13 workforce development programs supported by more than 17 funding sources. Employ Prince George's serves as the link between job seekers looking to begin or change careers, and businesses looking for skilled workers to maintain competitiveness in a changing labor market.



PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY HOURLY EMPLOYEE RELIEF FUND

In response to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, Employ Prince George's and Partners, launched the Prince George's County COVID-19 Hourly Employee Relief Fund to assist Prince George's County resident who were laid off or had decreased wages due to the pandemic.

This fund provided \$200 and \$300 Visa Cash Cards to pre-approved Prince George's County residents through community disbursements held throughout Prince George's County. **5,677** residents applied through Employ Prince George's virtual workforce portal, www.employpgedge.com.

Year To Date

The Prince George's County Hourly Employee Relief Fund disbursed \$709,300, via in \$200 and \$300 cash cards, to 3,032 Prince George's County residents. Along with 639 coats.

From April through December Employ Prince George's hosted 22 community disbursements.

Complete the required applicant questionnaire

Prince George's County residents who received a \$200 Visa cash card previously, are eligible to reapply to receive a \$300 cash card.

Step 4

Upload the required documentation to confirm your layoff is due to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) Pandemic

Employ Prince George's assesses all **Prince George's County** applicants of the Prince George's County COVID-19 Hourly Employee Relief Fund applications one by one. There are limited financial resources available and priority will be given to hourly workers who earned \$19 or less prior to being laid off due to the pandemic.



Through a partnership with Career Team,
Employ Prince George's is launching a

Services will include virtual orientations, one-on-one career coaching, career pathway planning, and soft skills training.



Along with mandated WIOA Title I
Workforce Development Service Providers,
WIOA also mandates that each state have
an Eligible Training Provider List. The State
of Maryland's Eligible Training Provider List
(ETPL) is managed by the Maryland
Department of Labor.

The ETPL is a database of all the occupational skills training courses and program, along with post-secondary institutions and private career schools, approved to receive WIOA funding by Local Workforce Development Area WIOA Title I Service Providers.
