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(9) For a mobile vendor license under Section 5-190 (h)(2), a description of
the areas in the County targeted for mobile food vending. Targeted areas shall include Health
Food Priority Areas as designated on the Prince George's County Healthy Food Priority Area
Map and any other authorized food truck locations under the County Code.

(c) Every application shall be signed and certified that the information given thereon is true and correct. The signature shall be that of the applicant.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the provisions of this Act are hereby declared to be severable; and, in the event that any section, subsection, paragraph, subparagraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Act is declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, subparagraphs, paragraphs, subsections, or sections of this Act, since the same would have been enacted without the incorporation in this Act of any such invalid or unconstitutional word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, subparagraph, subsection, or section.

SECTION 3. BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that this Act shall take effect forty-five (45) calendar days after it becomes law.
