Dear Chairman Hawkins:

Enclosed for the County Council's consideration is a Resolution providing for the continuation of the benefits for Prince George's County (the "County") employees called to active duty in the National Guard of the United States or Reserves as a result of the terrorist attacks on September 11, 2001, the resultant war on terrorism and military action in Afghanistan and Iraq. The Resolution provides:

- Eligibility for a salary supplement equaling the difference between the employee's base County rate of pay and his/her base military rate of pay, without the employee having to exhaust his/her annual, personal and compensatory leave.
- Eligibility for health care benefits to continue once the employee enters a leave without pay status, with the County paying both the employer and the employee portions of the premium.

Previously, the Council adopted CR-19-2019 to provide for the above stated military leave benefits. There are twenty (20) County employees who are serving abroad and are currently receiving benefits pursuant to CR-19-2019. The enclosed legislation will continue those benefits, that per CR-19-2021, would otherwise expire March 1, 2021.
