REPORT: Favorable 10-0: Council Members Hawkins, Davis, Dernoga, Franklin, Glaros, Harrison, Ivey, Streeter, Taveras, and Turner. Absent: Anderson-Walker

The Prince George's County Council convened as the Committee of the Whole on June 17, 2021, to consider CR-066-2021. As proposed, CR-066-2021 will set the FY 22 rate for the Public Safety Surcharge.

The new rate is based on the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) from April 2020 to April 2021. This is a 4.2% increase. Based upon this increase, the Public Safety surcharge for FY 22 shall increase by \$111 to \$2,749 for the developed tier and \$332 to \$8,241 for all other areas.

The Policy Group finds that adoption of CR-066-2021 will have no adverse fiscal impact on the County.

The Office of Law reports CR-066-2021 to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

After discussion, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole voted CR-066-2021 out favorable, 10-0.
