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**REPORT:** Favorable 10-0: Council Members Hawkins, Davis, Dernoga, Franklin, Glaros, Harrison, Ivey, Streeter, Taveras, and Turner. Absent: Anderson-Walker

The Prince George's County Council convened as the Committee of the Whole on June 17, 2021, to consider CR-065-2021.

As proposed, CR-065-2021 will set the rate for the School Facilities Surcharge effective July 1, 2021. This change is based on inflation in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U) from April 2020 to April 2021. The increase of 4.2%. The new fee shall increase by \$410 to \$10,180 for permits in the developed tier. The fee for permits issued in all other areas shall increase by \$703 to \$17,451.

The Policy Group finds that adoption of CR-065-2021 will have no adverse fiscal impact on the County.

The Office of Law finds CR-065-2021 to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

After discussion, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole voted CR-065-2021 out favorable, 10-0.
