

We provide care for 5 professional sports organizations, 15 collegiate organizations, 8 local, well known races/marathons, and 13 recreational teams and other affiliations.











Population & Community Health

- The team focused on providing COVID-19 vaccinations to our community, from February 2021 to June 2021.
 - MedStar Southern Maryland received an HSCRC grant to continue vaccination efforts in underserved areas of the county.
- Dr. Chile Ahaghotu, our Vice President, Medical Affairs, presented in several local virtual community meetings this past year. Topics included COVID-19 vaccinations, men's health and an overview of our new emergency department.
- Screening, Brief Intervention, and Referral to Treatment (SBIRT) remains a high priority for our hospital.
- As a member of TLC MD, MedStar Southern Maryland received funding from two HSCRC Catalyst Grants in FY21.
 - The first grant will help us to provide community-based behavioral healthcare in our region.
 - The second grant will help us to expand diabetes prevention and self-management program access. We will also provide support services, including medication and supply drop-off and nutrition counseling.

In FY21, there were:

- ZERO infections related to hip and knee replacements.
- ZERO MRSA infections for the second year in a row.
- ZERO catheter and central line associated infections in our ICU (CAUTIs and CLABSIs)
- Top decile (Vizient) results in hospital C.
 difficile infections and maternal mortality.

A New Beginning

- We broke ground in September 2019.
- Despite COVID-19, construction was never delayed. We stayed on track and opened on time.
- Total cost of this project was \$43M.
- Over \$1M of this project was funded through philanthropy and grants. This included donations from over 100 enthusiastic MedStar Health associates, and \$500K was provided through a grant from the state of Maryland.
