**REPORT:** Committee Vote: No Recommendation, 8-0 (In favor: Council Members Hawkins, Davis, Dernoga, Glaros, Harrison, Ivey, Streeter, and Taveras)

The County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole, convened on July 1, 2021 to consider CB-42-2021. After reading of the bill title, the Council Chairman turned to Council Member Streeter, the bill's sponsor, for comments. The Chairman also informed the Committee that Mr. Arthur Horne (representing Mission of Love) was present to speak if necessary.

Council Member Streeter thanked his colleagues for joining with him to sponsor the legislation to assist Mission of Love, a pillar in the community, in continuing to provide and expand their services to some of the most vulnerable citizens in the County. Mr. Streeter explained that there were ongoing discussions concerning non-substantive amendments to CB-42-2021 and his desire to report the bill out with No Recommendation to allow review of the final amendments at the public hearing and prior to enactment of the legislation.

The Council's Zoning and Legislative Counsel clarified that the legislation bypassed presentation and went straight to introduction; therefore, no substantive amendments could be made to the legislation during the Committee and that Council Member Streeter's direction for the motion was appropriate.

On a motion by Council Member Streeter, and second by Council Member Davis, the Committee of the Whole voted No Recommendation, 8-0, on CB-42-2021.
