WHEREAS	S, the United States has always been a Nation of immigrants, and throughout the	
Nation's history, immigrants and their children from around the globe have kept our workforce		
vibrant, our businesses on the cutting edge, and helped to build the greatest economic engine in		
the world; and		
WHEREAS	S, the estimated number of foreign born in Prince George's County is about one-	
quarter of its population; and		
WHEREAS	S, the entrepreneurial drive and spirit of the Nation is built on our diversity of	
origins; and		
WHEREAS	S, it is the American dream that first drew people to the United States and	
continues to drive business in the Nation; and		
WHEREAS	S, the success of the United States is a result of our many distinct experiences,	
not in spite of it; and		
WHEREAS	S, immigrants were also responsible in writing the constitution of this country	
and building the framework that we still use today such as Alexander Hamilton, who was an
