Whereas, F	acing the pandemic, damaging floods or drought, winter weather, or the lasting	
effects of Hurric	ane Ida, it is vital that Marylanders remain prepared for any disaster;	
Whereas, V	Ve have seen communities across Maryland, band together to support their	
fellow neighbors	s in the face of disaster. Our individual and collective preparedness is vital to	
handle any threa	ts and reduce the loss of life and property. It is imperative that we all work	
together to devel	op preparedness plans which can help minimize the impact of disaster for	
ourselves, our fa	milies, and our communities;	
Whereas, In	ndividuals and families are encouraged to develop and practice emergency plans	
to protect their h	ousehold and property by taking time to create a communication strategy, decide	
on an emergency	meeting location, build a three-day disaster preparedness kit, and sign up for

Whereas, Property owners in flood-prone areas are encouraged to research and consider obtaining flood insurance through the National Flood Insurance Program, as well as review any existing policies;

Whereas, During National Preparedness Month, we also recognize the bravery and the sacrifices of our first responders, who are our first line of defense in so many crises. This month, as we commemorate the 20th anniversary of the horrific terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001, we honor the lives that were lost and the heroism that was displayed by both first responders and ordinary citizens, and we reaffirm our responsibility to "never forget;" and

Whereas, We can mitigate the lasting and damaging effects of disasters by staying prepared. Each September, the State of Maryland participates in National Preparedness Month and renews our commitment to promoting emergency preparedness in homes, businesses, and communities across the State.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Prince George's County Council recognizes September as National Preparedness Month.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the County Council of Prince George's County, Maryland, that the Prince George's County Council:

- (1) Encourages all Marylanders to remain mindful of both natural and manmade disasters. As the conditions of potential threats can change rapidly, it is essential to understand and heed warnings from local officials and emergency management personnel.
- (2) Continues to ask all Prince Georgians to get vaccinated, turn on emergency alerts on their smartphones, pack an emergency go-bag, and encourage others in your community to do the same.
- (3) Encourages Marylanders in getting prepared and urge them to visit the Federal Emergency Management Agency's Ready campaign at www.Ready.gov or www.Listo.gov for Spanish-speakers for free information and resources to help all "Prepare to Protect."
