REPORT: Favorable 10-0: Council Members Hawkins, Anderson-Walker, Davis, Dernoga, Franklin, Glaros, Harrison, Ivey, Taveras and Turner. Absent: Streeter.

The Prince George's County Council convened as the Committee of the Whole on October 7, 2021, to consider CB-108-2021. As proposed, CB-108-2021 will approve the Collective Bargaining Agreement by and between Prince George's County and the International Association of Firefighters, AFL-CIO, Local 1619 (Civilians). In addition, CB-108-2021 is the companion legislation to the CR-101-2021 salary plan.

While many of the benefits in the previous agreement remain, many modifications are contained in the attached settlement summary. Salary members covered under this agreement shall receive a merit increase for FY 21 and FY 22. In addition, they will receive Hazard Pay from September 27, 2020, through April 24, 2021.

The Office of Law finds CB-108-2021 in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its enactment.

The Policy group, per the Office of Management and Budget, finds that CB-108-2021 will cost \$461,505 for one fiscal year.

After discussion, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole, reported CB-108-2021 out favorably, 10-0.
