REPORT: Favorable 10-0: Council Members Hawkins, Anderson-Walker Davis, Dernoga Franklin, Glaros, Harrison, Ivey, Taveras, and Turner. Absent: Streeter.

The Prince George's County Council convened as the Committee of the Whole on October 28, 2021, to consider CR-118-2021. CR-118-2021 is a resolution amending Salary Schedule "CO" for Corrections Officials in the Department of Corrections, effective July 1, 2020, through June 30, 2022. This legislation is necessary to implement certain modifications to wages and other benefits of Captains and Majors in the Department of Corrections.

This Salary Plan includes the following modifications: merit increases, maximum wage scale adjustment, retroactive COVID-19 Hazard Pay for the period of September 27, 2020, through April 24, 2021, and a temporary increase of the maximum annual leave carryover for the leave year 2021 into the leave year 2022. A settlement summary is included.

The Office of Law reports CR-118-2021 to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

The Policy Group reports that CR-118-2021 will have a negative impact on the County in the amount of \$70,456.

After discussion, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole, voted CR-118-2021 out favorably, 10-0.
