PURPOSE OF SECTION 3 ACTION PLAN

To ensure that economic opportunities, most importantly **employment**, generated by certain HUD financial assistance shall be directed to **low- and very low-income persons**. The Prince George's County Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) is the lead agency responsible for administering the following federal programs: **CDBG, HOME and ESG.**

WHEN DOES SECTION 3 APPLY

Whenever the total amount of HUD financial assistance provided to housing rehabilitation, housing construction, and other public construction projects exceeds \$200,000 dollars the project is defined by HUD as "Section 3" covered project.

Section 3 applies to the **entire project**, regardless of whether the project is fully or partially assisted under HUD programs.

SECTION 3 REQUIREMENTS



Thirty-five percent (35%) of the total number of labor hours worked by all workers on a Section 3 project are Section 3 workers; and

Five percent (5%) of the total number of labor hours worked by all workers on a Section 3 project are Targeted Section 3 workers.

This means that the five percent (5%) is included as part of the twenty-five percent (35%) threshold.

DEFINITIONS

SECTION 3 WORKER

A Section 3 Worker is any worker who currently fits, or when hired within the past five years fit, at least one of the following categories, as documented:

- A low or very low-income individual
- Employed by a Section 3 business concern
- A Youthbuild participant

TARGETED SECTION 3 WORKER

Employed by a Section 3 business concern

OR

Currently fits or when hired fit at least one of the following categories as documented within the past five years:

- Living within the service area or the neighborhood of the project,
- YouthBuild participant

DEFINITIONS

Section 3 business concern meets one of the following three criteria:

- 51% or more owned and controlled by low or very-low income persons, OR
- Over 75% of the labor hours performed for the business over the prior three-month period are performed by Section 3 workers, OR
- 51% or more owned and controlled by current residents of public housing or Section 8-assisted housing

Who are Section 3 residents?

- Public housing residents, OR
- Low and very-low-income persons who live in the metropolitan area or non-metropolitan county where a HUD-assisted project for housing or community development is located.

IMPLEMENTATION

Outreach, engagement and referrals to the Employ Prince George's Construction Works Program.

Section 3 Safe Harbor requirements included in NOFA, bid solicitations and in contract agreements
