REPORT: Favorable 9-0: Council Members Hawkins, Davis, Dernoga, Franklin, Glaros, Harrison, Ivey, Taveras, and Turner, Absent: Streeter, Council District 8 Vacant.

The Prince George's County Council convened as the Committee of the Whole on November 9, 2021, to consider CR-132-2021. CR-132-2021 is a Resolution for appropriating funding from grants in the amount of \$23,180,241 for Fiscal Year 2022. This request for additional appropriation authority will support new and continuing grant program efforts of eight agencies and Non-Departmental. The agencies requesting additional appropriations are listed below.

Circuit Court - \$ 127,000

Department of Corrections - \$86,711 Fire Department - \$15,250

Police Department - \$1,571,258

Department of Housing and Community

Development - \$405,237

Department of Family Services - \$1,899,552

Health Department - \$13.828,832

Department of Social Services - \$249,110

Non-Departmental - \$5,000,000

A majority of these funds will allow a myriad of grant programs to continue. The Non-Departmental funding will support an online sales network and equipment for teleworking opportunities. CR-132-2021 will require a County match of \$392,608 dollars.

The Office of Law reports CR-132-2021 to be in proper legislative form with no legal impediments to its adoption.

The adoption of CR-132-2021 will have a positive impact on the County in that these funds will continue to support needed grant funded programs.

After discussion, the Prince George's County Council, sitting as the Committee of the Whole, reported CR-132-2021 out favorably, 9-0.
