Council Member Franklin proferred an additional similar exemption for inclusion. Under discussion on the motion, Council Member Lehman requested further clarification of the Planning Board's positions on these bills, to which Alan Hirsch responded on behalf of the Planning Department. Council Member Patterson expressed concern about the timing of these measures.
