Jacqueline Brown, Director of the PZED Committee, provided an overview of the measure and noted a memorandum from the Planning Board expressing opposition to the bill with an explanation. Council Member Glaros requested that Council Bills 72 and 85 be discussed in tandem for possible incorporation into one bill. Council Member Franklin proferred an additional similar exemption for inclusion. Under discussion on the motion, Council Member Lehman requested further clarification of the Planning Board's positions on these bills, to which Alan Hirsch responded on behalf of the Planning Department. Council Member Patterson expressed concern about the timing of these measures.

A motion was made by Council Member Turner, seconded by Council Member Franklin, that this Council Bill be Favorably recommended with amendments to the County Council. The motion carried by the following vote:
