Bryan Barnett-Woods, Planner Coordinator, and Brittany Drakeford, Senior Planner, M-NCPPC facilitated a PowerPoint presentation which focused on: outreach and comments in total, comment categories and what was heard with regard to general support, healthy communities, neighborhood protection, municipal inclusion, procedures, public engagement, standards, landscape manual, green building, uses, fast food uses and drive through service, combination retail, and newspaper/periodical publication. The panelists responded to questions posed by the Council regarding: health impact assessment, notice requirements for administrative review, mixed-use percentages, standards for large retail establishments, non-conforming uses, detailed site plan review requirements by project size, sign posting, description of fast food services, storage units, neighborhood conservation overlay zone, shipping containers, pre-application meetings. Chairman Glaros outlined next steps for this project.
