authorizing the acquisition by the County of the IDA's interests in the DuVall Wing
Restoration Project and the Upper Marlboro Justice Center Project; authorizing the
transfer of the County's interests in the DuVall Wing Restoration Project and the
Upper Marlboro Justice Center Project to the Revenue Authority (defined herein)

following the redemption of the IDA Bonds; authorizing the execution of a lease agreement between the County and the Revenue Authority for the Upper Marlboro Justice Center and Gabriel DuVall Law Building; approving an amendment to the existing Justice Center Sublease between the County and the State for a portion of the DuVall Wing Restoration Project; and upon termination of the IDA, transferring title to all of the remaining assets and obligations of the IDA to the Revenue Authority.
