Dr. Fullum facilitated a PowerPoint presentation on social determinants of health and health disparities and responded to questions posed by the Council regarding: human services, primary care physicians, life-expectancy, health equity, environmental justice and the community health needs assessment. Dr. Hancock, spoke to a handout on modifiable and unmodifiable contributors to obesity and responded to questions posed by the Council regarding stress as a contributor. Council Members expressed topics that would be of interest this year.
