Mr. Martin Harris, Deputy Director, Department of Public Works and Transportation and Mr. Victor Weissberg, Special Assistant, Department of Public Works and Transportation spoke to the new draft of the Transportation Priorities letter that includes the changes as discussed in the Committee of the Whole Worksession held on January 28, 2020. These amendments were made to the State Programs and Projects Transit list, the SHA Construction Priorities order and the inclusion of projects from the 2019 letter, language to clarify what is requested for Construction, Project Planning, Gateway Beautification and Park Trail Priorities. Council Member Glaros requested that the discussion on the next CTP letter begin earlier in the year, perhaps in the Transportation, Infrastructure, Energy and Environment (TIEE) Committee. Council Chair Turner requested that several projects, including the MD-197, MD-450, John Hanson Highway and Bicycle Bowie Heritage Trail projects be restored.

A motion was made by Member Davis, seconded by Member Glaros, that this Agenda Letter be Favorably recommended with amendments to the County Council. The motion carried by the following vote:
