The 2018 Water and Sewer Plan provides for four cycles of category change requests annually to amend the Plan. This Resolution represents the January

2020 Cycle of Amendments. The 2018 Water and Sewer Plan was adopted by CR-64-2019, and amended by CR-75-2019. There is one (1) category change requested in the Piscataway sewer basin; the Department of Permitting, Inspections and Enforcement has modified maps of residential properties to reflect the existing sewer service category; and, there are text revisions to Chapter 6, Appendix 6-1, and Appendix 6-2. The Council Chair announced that this Resolution requires a public hearing.

Ms. Gross-Wade outlined the implementation plan developed for the fund. Deputy Chief Administrative Officer Angie Rodgers was also present. The panelists responded to questions posed by Council Members regarding the need for additional language regarding those individuals who will not be able to repay the loans being offered; language to include grants in the amount of \$5,000 for those businesses with 10 or less employees and \$10,000 with more than 10 employees; independent contractors; specified uses of the funds; fee structure; the need for translated materials for non-english speaking business; regular Council updates.
