The Panelists responded to questions by Council Members regarding parent support centers, hotspot availability, disengaged students, ambitious class schedules, school needs and working parents, after school programs/virtual experiences, availability of meals for those unable to pickup, administrative staff safety, future learning options, point of contact, ability to recognize cases of abuse and mandatory check-ins.
