The Prince George's County Code does not currently require a landlord to supply and maintain provided air conditioning equipment in a safe and good working condition. Therefore, this bill requires that a landlord provide equipment that will cool an inside temperature to eighty degrees Farenheut (800 F) or less between the dates of June 1 and September 30 each year. The bill also exempts single family and historic properties. It allows tenants to opt out of the requirement under certain circumstances. It also allows the

Department of Permitting, Inspection, and Enforcement to temporarily exempt certain buildings from the requirement when a qualifying building is awaiting redevelopment.

The Homestead Property Tax Credit was created to limit taxable assessment increases on a property owner's principal residence.
