Rhonda Weaver, County Attorney, gave an overview of the resolution. She stated that the declaration of emergency shall stay in effect through February

18, 2021.unless amended or terminated sooner by the County Executive or as extended by a subsequent resolution of the governing body.

Dr. Ernest Carter, Health Officer, and Ronald Gill, Jr., Director of Emergency Management, also briefed the Committee on the status of COVID-19 efforts in the County and the need to continue the emergency declaration. The panelists responded to questions posed by Council Members regarding vaccinations including distribution, phases, locations and the percentage of health care workers being vaccinated; concern surrounding fitness centers and face covering compliance; and dine in transmission risks. An amendment was offered to revise the resolution to include up-to-date health data.

A motion was made by Member Turner, seconded by Member Davis, that this Resolution be Favorably recommended with amendments. The motion carried by the following vote:
